Existing or new tools needed?

- > Tools for Business Continuity Planning:
 - > Smaller businesses (100 staff or less)
 - > BC Planning template tools
 - Larger businesses (over 100 staff)
 - Dedicated BC planning tools
- > Tools for managing or communicating in a crisis:
 - Smaller organisations (100 staff or less)
 - > Ad-hoc tools: WhatsApp, email, call-trees
 - > HOWEVER know the risks & limitations
 - Larger businesses (100 staff and greater)
 - Integrated, automated CrisisCommunication & Management tools
 - Easier to control and admin
 - > Easier to manage contact info & groups
 - > Better for data security
 - Much faster to communicate & respond
 - Vital to use private contact details



How should I communicate with my staff, & key stakeholders during these rapid & fluid changes?

- > Perfect for crisis management & comms system
 - > Frequent comms to cut-through the confusion
 - > Send daily '2-way' stakeholder message
 - > Instruct; tasks, roles for safety & productivity
 - > Staff respond with number on the key-pad
 - > All work and private contact details
 - Make sure you group staff by location
- Singapore client using F24 communication tools
 - > Manufacturing ventilators for Covid Crisis
 - > Workforce informed, safe and present
 - Keeping production lines going at critical time
 - Production line staff have no company email addresses or company mobile phones!



How do I ensure employee safety?

- > Standard practices for Hygiene
- > Do organisations have a duty to monitor & remedy?
- > Simple way for any member of staff to raise alert.
