Risk isn't just something managed through policies, frameworks, or risk teams—it's managed every day through the decisions people make when no one is watching. This course shows how good risk culture supports better outcomes, helps organisations manage uncertainty, and prevents small issues from turning into serious incidents.

The course focuses on practical, day-to-day behaviors that make the biggest difference: speaking up, challenging respectfully, staying risk-aware, and making balanced risk-reward decisions. Learners will understand how informal, subconscious risk management is supported by formal frameworks, how responsibilities differ across the organization, and why risk culture must be reinforced continuously. By the end of the course, participants will feel confident doing the right thing, influencing those around them, and contributing to a strong, sustainable risk culture.
